Dear Macbeth Tournament Participant,

Welcome to the 66th Norman Macbeth Invitational Tournament. We are pleased that you could be with us. Here are a few things to remember:

- You will be given a lapel pin which entitles you to beverages such as beer, wine by the glass, and well drinks throughout the event. Your guests and non-participants will be asked to sign for their drinks. Be sure to have your lapel pin on you during the weekend if you wish to take advantage of this benefit. Please see insert.
- Be sure to pick up your tee prizes in the Clubhouse when you arrive. This year, we are featuring apparel from TaylorMade, Adidas and Ashworth.
- We will have another full field this year. Again, we will adhere to our rule that imposes penalties for those who are late for their tee times. Please review the Pace of Play Guidelines included in this packet. You will be expected to be familiar and in compliance with these rules.
- Once again, we will be actively monitoring pace of play and employing a "time par". Anyone missing "time par" is subject to a slow play penalty, so please be conscious of that and do what you can to keep on pace. Better ball rounds should take no longer than 4:15 and Aggregate rounds should take no longer than 4:40. Please keep up with the group in front of you and play ready golf when you are able. Please help our marshals identify any groups falling out of position.
- Scorekeepers must record a score for each hole for each player on the scorecards for Friday and Saturday play. If you are out of a hole on better ball days, pick up, and use Equitable Stroke Control Rules. Individual scores for all three days will be turned in for handicap purposes with the Sunday round being designated as a Tournament Score.
- As always, we will have volunteers shuttling players to and from the range. Do not use individual carts to access the range during the tournament.
- All are welcome to gallery the Derby and to attend our Mexican Fiesta Buffet.

Please contact David Tucker or Nelson Amaya to let them know whether you and a guest will be attending the Sunday night awards event.
